- » 3 hour sessions (8:30 – 11:30 AM & 12:30 – 3:30 PM)

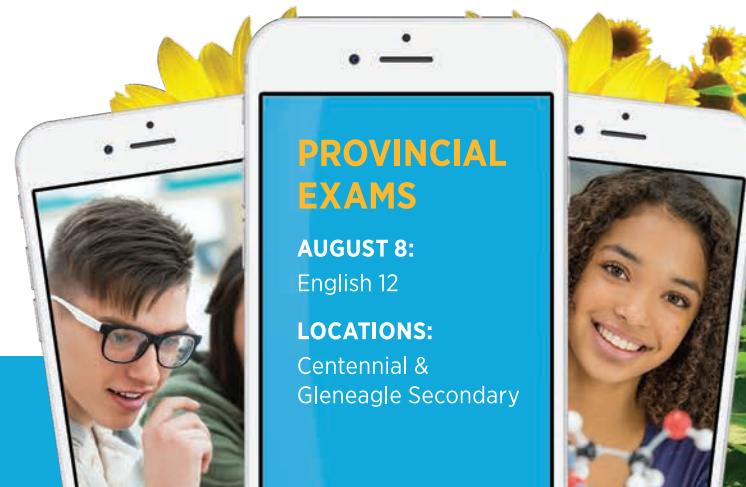
### ONLINE (3 DAYS):
