Summer Learning Remedial Courses:

Remedial courses are for Grade 9 and 10 students who were unsuccessful (40-49%) during the school year and are being given the opportunity to receive retroactive credit (a passing grade) for the course by attending Summer Learning. **Daily attendance is necessary for success.**

Grade 9 Remedial: classes will begin with an assessment of each student's skill levels then target skill gaps with intensive remediation. The focus will be on building skills related to course content, organizational skills, and study skills.

Grade 10 Remedial: students will review course material and units that they did not successfully complete during the school year. English 10 will focus on Composition and Literary Studies modules. Organizational and study skills will also be a focus.

Registration for Remedial courses is by referral only, using this form. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. Please submit this completed form, with both sides completed and all required signatures, **between April 1 and June 21 2019:**
